A married men's race and a Duck hunt – first prize? A Duck – supplied in 1911 by Mr W Hammond. As far as we can trace this is where the Stanley Cup originated – first presented on January the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1911 – so this year marks the hundred year anniversary of this our oldest surviving trophy.

To all those parents and caregivers who came to the pool to help during the season, thank you so much. There are many things to do to make sure the swimmers get the best use of time in the pool and all help is appreciated. Our special thanks go to Michelle Cooper, Steve Malthus and Jos Pattison for their extra help with pool duties in closing up, also to all the swimmers that helped.

Thank you again so much to our coaches Lisa Hunt, Seane Watkins, Michelle Cooper and Jos Pattison who have enthusiastically given up their time to coach our swimmers to develop their potential. I believe Waimea Swimming Club teaches children to further their swimming, gaining perseverance and stamina and providing

## **President's Report 2010/11**

### **Nelson South Swimming Club**

During the 2010/11 year Nelson South enjoyed significant success in the pool, with swimmers performing very well in local meets, and a large number of swimmers qualifying for national meets. We are supporting some of our senior swimmers to develop coaching skills, through delivering the programme to junior swimmers. I acknowledge that there is more to be done in this area to ensure we are providing a quality programme for juniors, and we are working alongside other clubs to confirm a structure that will provide clear support and mentoring for the assistant coaches.

Away from the swimming, there have been a few notable activities:

- Reinstating stairs to the club-house
- Signing a new agreement with Pattison Swimming
- Working with Hampden St School to support enhancements to the environment around the pool
- Working with other Nelson swimming clubs to reduce duplication and make better use of shared resources
- The Fiji trip
- Increased membership
- A solid financial result
- Ongoing analysis of electricity consumption giving us a better understanding of where and when power is used (big pool vs small pool, and heating vs circulation pumps)
- A complete end of season review of the filtering system
- Enhancements to the club website

The biggest challenge we face right now is access to adequate lane space at a reasonable price for winter training. We have a positive and harmonious relationship with the team at Riverside, and while we would like more lanes and time, we are able to offer swimmers effective winter training. Significant negotiations with Aquatic Centre management and Tasman District Council representatives have achieved only 2 sessions of 3 lanes per week, late evening and shared between swimmers from 4 clubs. As everyone will be aware, CLM has introduced the Tasman Magic Academy, and virtually all the pool space that had previously been available for clubs is now booked out to the Academy. CLM denies that clubs are blocked from training at the Aquatic Centre, noting that swimmers are welcome to train with the Academy. They refuse to enter into any discussion about the fact that this option means that swimmers must abandon their coach of choice, as CLM won't allow club coaches to be poolside with swimmers who are training with the Academy. As we move through the negotiations with CLM, it is becoming clear that CLM plans to establish a club that will be based at the Aquatic Centre and trained through the Academy. It is not clear where CLM Riverside fits into the planning. Denying existing clubs access to adequate pool space will leave swimmers with no choice but to join the Academy for winter training, and it must be assumed that swimmers would also have no choice other than to join the CLM club.

As your representative in these negotiations, I must be led by the views of the club members. As more information is available I will provide this to the membership so that informed decisions can be made. It is fair to say that your committee, and representatives from other clubs, are not happy with these recent developments and we are working on a multi-pronged strategy to try and achieve fair access to the Aquatic Centre for training.

I am proud to be the president of a club that not only supports swimmers to swim fast, but also encourages positive values. We see this in the way that swimmers support one another, approach competition with determination but a strong sense of fairness, and maintain strong friendships with people from other clubs, sharing knowledge and encouraging the best in one another. I am confident that swimmers who spend time at Nelson South emerge as not only better swimmers, but as better people.

Finally I want to publicly thank the 2010/11 committee and particularly the executive. Liz, Lindie, Kareen and I have debated many issues over the last year and hopefully you will feel that decisions made have been in the best interests of the club and members. Lindie is stepping down as secretary - she has done an amazing job for you all, and leaves the role with good systems and structures in place for the next person to work with.
